VETERINARY CERTIFICATE

In order for a veterinary certificate to be justified in relation to for example presenting a dog at a dog show, the veterinarian must **be able to make a solemn declaration that he/she has previously established personally that the dog in question has been normal as regards the disease in question.** Consequently, the veterinarian must not base his/her statement on information acquired from the owner of the dog. The previous normal condition must have been noted by personal inspection.

This certificate is employed in connection with shows, trials and registration under the auspices of the DKK.
